American Institute of Architects Elevates Daniel Rothschild to the College of Fellows

The American Institute of Architects has elevated 88 AIA members to its prestigious College of Fellows, AIA's highest membership honor, for their exceptional work and contributions to architecture and society. One AIA Pennsylvania member Daniel Rothschild, FAIA, founder and Chief Executive Officer of Rothschild Doyno Collaborative, an architecture and urban design firm based in Pittsburgh, is among the 2022 Class of Fellows from across the nation.

Rothschild has advanced architectural practice by creating an equitable Graphic Storytelling method that expands the number of diverse voices included in the design process to create more inclusive and meaningful design outcomes. He provides design, graphic, and communication leadership through the use of the firm's Design Sketchbook process and active participation in architecture and urban design projects. His commitment to the design narrative has helped to form the collaborative environment of the firm.

Dan has extended his leadership to the architectural community with the Regent Square Civic



Association, the Pittsburgh Executives Association, and through six years of service to the American Institute of Architecture Pittsburgh chapter including the role of President. He has served as an Adjunct Professor at Carnegie Mellon in the Urban Lab, and has lectured at local universities. Recently, Dan served as President of Temple Emanuel. He is Co-Founder and Facilitator of AIA Pittsburgh Foundation's Leadership Institute for Emerging Professionals.

The fellowship program was developed to elevate those

architects who have achieved a standard of excellence in the profession and made a significant contribution to architecture and society on a national level. Architects who have been elevated to fellowship can be identified by the designation FAIA after their name. Only 3 percent of architects nationally have been awarded this honor.

Daniel and his inductee peers will be honored at the 2022 AIA College of Fellows Investiture Ceremony on June 24 in Chicago during the AIA Conference on Architecture 2022.
